

STUDENT'S RULES OF CONDUCT

General Conduct

1. Students are expected to be punctual to all activities involved in, including getting up on time in the morning for school.
2. Students who use, write, distribute, or possess profane, indecent or obscene language, literature, writing, or pictures will be returned to their home country.
3. Students are not permitted to use tobacco, alcohol, or illegal drugs.
4. Students are not allowed to fight verbally or physically.
5. Students should reflect the high standards of Christian morals and principles. It is therefore expected of each student to refrain from public display of affection (such as kissing, holding hands, embracing, etc.). Students should not be involved in a dating relationship.
6. Participation with secular rock music is not permitted. Students will not be allowed to have or play secular music.
7. Students are not to be involved in any sexual immorality.
8. Gambling, in any form, will not be tolerated.
9. Cheating, lying, or stealing will not be tolerated.
10. Scoffing, scorning, disrespectful remarks and/or behavior are not acceptable.
11. Involvement in witchcraft, the occult, astrology, Dungeons and Dragons, etc. are not allowed.
12. Students will show respect for the authority of the Homestay Parents. Disobedience and verbal disrespect are not acceptable.
13. If a student commits an offence under the Canadian Law they will be dealt with by the police and Canada Immigration and sent home.
14. I understand that if my behavior does not follow the Code of Conduct, I may be sent home at my own expense.
